

PERFORMING ARTS THEATER RENTAL RATES

 - (2) Rates are price per hour, two-hour minimum per day.

NATURE OF ACTIVITY OR EVENT	Where <u>NO</u> admission is charged, donations sought, articles sold, or offerings taken. FREE AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.	Where admission IS charged, donations sought, articles sold, offerings, etc. OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR A FEE	Where admission is limited or restricted to specific individuals such as members, guests. NOT INTENDED FOR OR OPEN TO THE PUBLIC.

Where it is determined by the school's Performing Arts Theater manager that lighting, sound equipment, piano, stage set-up/take-down, cleanup is required and/or that one or more custodians and/or lighting/sound technicians is required (or requested by applicant), the following extra two-hour minimum charges will apply over and above basic rental rate:

Upright Piano Use (per occurrence)	\$20.00 per occurrence
Lighting Fee	\$25.00/hour
Booking Fee	\$10.00 per scheduled event (collected from all users except schools)
